Use	Broker examination study planning. The current PSI bulletin controls if it changes.

Start with the current retake rule

If a broker candidate fails a portion, PSI provides diagnostic scoring information and reapplication instructions. The candidate repeats only the failed portion or portions. A broker has up to four attempts during the two-year eligibility period. After failing the fourth attempt, a non-exempt broker candidate must repeat the 75-hour broker pre-license education and the entire examination.
